The first thing you see is our rainbow of houses, right? That's because Wellspring has been in the business of providing supportive housing for 38 years and the COVID-19 pandemic has NOT stopped us. In fact, if anything, it puts more urgency into our efforts to get persons with mental illness off the streets or out of institutions and into their *own* homes.

During these frightening times, we want to help people reduce their risk of exposure by helping them move from high risk environments into settings where they have comfort and control over their own lives. We already support nearly 300 people in their own homes. We help them stay safe at home and we bring them necessary food and supplies—including prescription renewals—whatever it takes to keep them safe and to reduce exposure (for them and for others) to this frightening virus. That is not enough, though, as more people need our help **right now** and helping them helps us all by making our community just a little safer from the spread of COVID19.

After literally years on the streets and in the midst of a pandemic, "Joe", (pictured here), finally has a home of his own! Three cheers for "Joe" and his Wellspring case manager for making it happen!

"Joe" is one of a half dozen homeless adults with mental illness who have worked with Wellspring to find the safety, security, and comfort of their own home **during the past 10 days** despite nearly insurmountable odds.
