THE PROGRAM OFFERS A COMFORTABLE, COMMUNITY-BASED AND COST EFFECTIVE ALTERNATIVE TO INPATIENT HOSPITALIZATION FOR ADULTS WHO NEED AN INTENSIVE LEVEL OF SUPPORT BUT DO NOT REQUIRE THE LOCKED DOWN SAFETY OF AN INPATIENT HOSPITAL. THESE CRISIS STABILIAZATION UNITS(CSUS) ARE LICENSED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF KY AND MONITORED BY THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL TO MEET QUALITY STANDARDS.
